

NOUGHTS & CROSSES - CLUB OPERATION QUIZ

Objective

To review and reinforce knowledge of a subject, typically at the end of a training session. This example of the game is based on the T.I. Club Constitution and The Standard Bylaws.

Procedure

Number a conventional noughts and crosses grid on a board/flip chart. Two teams are then asked questions alternately. If answered correctly, a team can nominate which number square their o or X is to be placed in. If a team misses an answer, the other side is given the opportunity to answer the question.

1. What is the minimum age a person can join Toastmasters?
18 years *Article II.1*
2. How many members constitute a quorum at a Club meeting?
A majority of the active membership *Article V.1*
3. Which part of its Constitution can an existing Club change?
None *Article XII.1*
4. A special meeting of a Club may be called by a majority vote at any meeting, or by?
The President *Bylaw Article IV.2*
5. Is a Club President an ex officio member of all Club Committees?
No (Not of the Nominating Committee) *Article VII.1*
6. Who is the fourth ranking club officer?
The Vice President Public Relations *Article VII.4*
7. Who is responsible for arranging proper induction of all new members?
The Membership Committee *Article VIII.4*
8. Who is responsible for managing the Club property?
The Sergeant At Arms *Article VII.7*
9. What proportion of members is needed to amend a Club Bylaw?
Two-thirds vote of active members present and voting *Bylaw Article VII.1*
10. How many representatives does a Club have on the District Council?
Two (President and Vice President Education) *Article VII.1 & 2*
